

# ITP QUADCROSS: WRAPPING 2005, PREVIEWING 2006

The ITP QuadCross Championship Series just keeps getting bigger and better. During its three-year history this ATV-only race program has grown in popularity, prestige and scope, quickly becoming the premier motocross race series in Southern California.

The 2005 QuadCross calendar concluded with a double-points event on the National Track at famed Glen Helen Raceway in Devore, California. Headlining the program—which featured 30 classes for riders of all ages and skill levels—was the Open Pro division. With nine events already in the books for the year, the championship chase had come down to a three-way title fight between Dustin Nelson, Dana Creech and two-time and defending champ Jeremy Schell. Adding to the excitement was the return of Kory Ellis, who had spent most of his season contesting the ITP/ATVA Grand National Championship Motocross Series.

Team Alba's Ellis would end up putting in a dominating



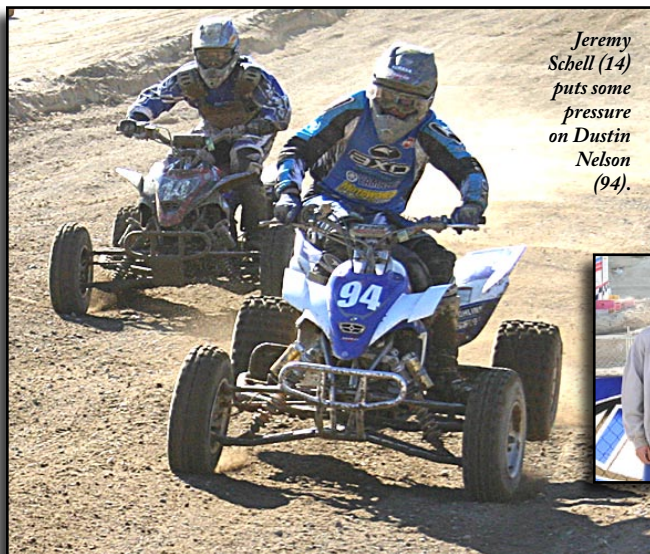

based, 450cc Pro division will offer a \$1,000/100%-payback purse, while the Open Pro class will compete for a 100% payback purse.

Back for 2006 will be a Yamaha YFZ450 giveaway. All ITP QuadCross participants receive one drawing entry for each race they enter during the season, for a chance to win a new YFZ450 equipped with GYT-R accessories, ITP Holeshot tires and ITP T-9 Pro Series wheels. At the final 2005 event at Glen Helen, a lucky Rafael Guzman had his name drawn and went home with a new Yamaha.

performance, finishing first in both motos. With that, the focus was turned to the action taking place just behind as Nelson, Creech and Schell battled for the number one plate. Creech managed to grab the runner-up spot in moto one, with Schell and Nelson nipping at his heels. This set the stage for a moto-two shootout, which began with a holeshot by Nelson. The top four put on a fanatastic show during the first few laps, swapping positions repeatedly. Ellis eventually put a lock on the lead while Nelson fell back with apparent mechanical issues. Creech needed to win and hope Schell met with disaster, but with Ellis taking the checkers first and Schell crossing the line in third behind Creech, the championship went once again to Golden West Cycles'
