



# NELSON WRAPS UP 2006 QUADCROSS TITLE, AIMS FOR 2007

*Dustin Nelson and his ITP-equipped Yamaha dominated the 2006 QuadCross Championship Series.*



The 4th Annual ITP/Yamaha QuadCross Championship Series proved to be a showcase for Dustin Nelson. The Motoworldracing.com/Dubach Racing-sponsored rider powered his Yamaha YFZ450 to victory in five of the series' 11 rounds and, combined with four other top-three podium appearances, ended up a runaway champion for the 2006 season in the premier Pro Production (265-450cc) division.

Nelson's Yamaha was equipped all year with ITP Holeshot tires mounted on ITP T-9 Pro Series wheels, doing the QuadCross Series sponsors proud! Finishing in the runner-up position for 2006 (with one win and three other top-threes) was another ITP Holeshot rider, Doug Eichner.

Shortly after confirming his QuadCross Championship — making him one of the few riders ever to win pro titles on both two and four wheels — it was announced that Nelson will be Yamaha factory-backed in 2007 and 2008, and will return to defend his title during the 5th Anniversary of the series. Nelson summed up his 2006 season by saying, "I had a really consistent year with no mechanical failures. My bike's reliability was huge and that made the difference."

The ITP/Yamaha QuadCross Championship Series continues to grow in terms of rider attendance, media attention and interest from the ATV manufacturers, making it one of the most popular and prestigious motocross race programs in the country. The 2007 series will once again be comprised of 11 events throughout California and Arizona, with a class available for riders of virtually any age or experience level and on most popular ATV models — even the Yamaha Rhino!

There will be plenty of cash up for grabs in the two Pro classes, including a \$1,000/100%-payback purse for the 450cc Pros and a 100% payback purse for the Open Pro class. And Yamaha will once again be conducting a Yamaha YFZ450 giveaway, open to all QuadCross entrants. Series participants receive one drawing entry for each race they enter during the season, for a chance to win a new YFZ450 equipped with GYT-R accessories, ITP Holeshot tires and ITP T-9 Pro Series wheels. The 2006 winner was Ed Dacosta, a competitor in the 91-450cc 4-Stroke Intermediate class.
